

THE PARIS AGREEMENT IS NON RE NEGOTIABLE PRESIDENT MACRON DECLARED

AFTER USA WITHDRAWAL FROM COP21 ACCORD

USPA NEWS - President Trump announced Thursday that he will withdraw the United States from participation in the Paris climate accord, weakening global efforts to combat climate change. French President Emmanuel Macron was the first to react to this decision that he "respects but considers a mistake for the planet and the world" during a declaration at the Elysee at 11 pm.

He added that "we will not renegotiate a less ambitious agreement on the Paris Climate Agreement". President Macron took the opportunity to invite "Researchers, experts and citizens committed to climate change to come to work in France" This hand extended of France goes against the American "pretext" of the loss of jobs that would generate by its constraints, the Paris Agreement on Climate, according to the estimates of the White House.

The President declared his determination and made two statements, one long in French and another shorter of 6 minutes in English, addressing President Trump. The second statement is in form of a video titled "Make Planet Great Again" in reference to Donald Trump's campaign slogan "Make America great again" It is an effort of translation that he wished to do himself to better target the American audience as well as their head of state Donald Trump. This marks a new form of Presidential communication at the Elysee in France, as well as the French President's desire to mark the strength and gravity of the message, in the name of protecting the planet and future generations. "I am sorry that Trump is disengaging from the Climate Accord, and I think he is making a mistake for the interest of his country and his people and a mistake for the future of Our planet. "I just spoke with President Trump and told him about it." Explained President Macron.-----

-----CLIMATE CHANGE IS THE LARGEST CHALLENGE OF OUR TIME-----

"What appeared a few years ago as an observation is nowadays to us all as a great evidence, biodiversity is threatened, desolation climatic infamous, Several continents devastate certain regions, chase the inhabitants of their homeland. France itself, we see every year this deregulation. If we do nothing our children will experience a world of migrations, wars, shortages of archipelago and coastal cities, caused by these evolutions, it has already begun, "added President Macron

THIS IS NOT THE FUTURE WE WANT FOR US AND OUR CHILDREN AND FOR THE WORLD-----

This is not the future we want for ourselves, our children and the world. The vocation of France is to lead these struggles which involve the entire humanity.. That is why France has placed itself at the forefront of the fight against climate change. It is firmly committed to all international negotiations. And in 2015, France succeeded this tour de force to have 195 countries sign a common commitment: the Paris Agreement for the climate" President Macron stated.

WE WILL NOT RENEGOTIATE A NEW LESS AMBITIOUS AGREEMENT THAN THE PARIS AGREEMENT-----

"So yes, I tell you this evening with great force we will not renegotiate a new agreement less ambitious, in no case. France is calling tonight all the countries signing the agreement to remain within the framework of the Paris agreement, to stand up to our responsibilities and not to yield anything.-----

I mean to the USA that France believes in you, that the world believes in you and I know that you are a very great nation to make freedom triumph the truth reason everywhere against ignorance and darkness but do not deceive you There is no plan B for the planet because there is no planet B. So yes, we will continue.." President Macron stated-----

THE PRESIDENT MACRON INVITES THE SCIENTISTS CITIZEN ENGINEERS COMMITTED TO COME TO WORK IN FRANCE ON CLIMATE-----

President Macron has launched a solemn appeal to scientists, climate contractors to settle in France and work on concrete solutions. "To all engineers, entrepreneurs, committed citizens, disappointed by the decision of their president, you will find in France a second homeland. I appeal to you, come to work here with us to work on concerted solutions on the climate. "

Tonight the US has turned its back on the world, France will not turn its back on the Americans

I assure you, my dear compatriots, and you who listen to me or that you are in the world, France will not give up the fight.

Of course we would have completed this battle on the United States of America as they are our allies and will remain our allies, on many subjects of fight against terrorism, defense, security, industrial and economic. But it's like that, "continued President

The head of state then recalled the strong and historic relations between France and the USA without ensuring the determination of the European alliance with the leading countries which are Germany and Italy."The door is not closed, it will never be to this nation to which we owe so much, and we are still numerous to retain our determination." France will therefore play its role in the world because this is what is expected of With Germany and Italy tonight, we wanted to reaffirm our commitment to the Paris Agreement, I spoke with the German Chancellor and we will take strong initiatives together in this direction.

President Macron anticipated the visit of the Indian Prime Minister, to which he will express his concern about the situation , given the importance of India in the global blame in terms of pollution and energy transition measures, since their signature at COP21 of the Paris Agreement-----

"Saturday I will see with the Indian Prime Minister in Paris and discuss this topic with him and the next week I will make sure in the next to the decision makers of their commitment. France will prepare a concrete plan of action to increase the attractiveness of researchers on the ecological transition and will take concrete actions in particular in Europe and in Africa on this subject. I have asked the government to work actively for this purpose and will meet them next week on this subject. We will not only keep our past commitments, the surrender of France more ambitious for the future, for the future. Long live the Republic, Long Live France,"concluded President Macron.
